



According to the Occupational Safety and Health standards for General Industry (OSHA), Section 1910.1200 Hazard Communication, (b) Scope and Application, (6) this section does not apply to iv) articles, (c) Definitions: Article means a manufactured item: (1) Which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture: (ii) which has end use functions dependent in whole or part upon its shape or design during end use: and (iii) which does not release, or otherwise result in exposure to, a Hazardous chemical, under normal conditions of use.

In the routine manufacturing of Emsig Manufacturing Corp. heat resistant Melamine buttons they are molded thus becoming a solid and non-hazardous under RCRA.

Emsig Manufacturing Corp., Heat resistant Melamine buttons are inert, and therefore are not required to have an MSDS sheet as stated above in the OSHA Statute 1910.1200.
